

The impact of VIG for professionals and families

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Abstract

This session will begin by presenting findings from two studies in Cornwall. First, we will present an evaluation of the Cornwall VIG service undertaken in 2016 which examined the impact of VIG upon families. Second, emerging findings from a current study looking at the impact of VIG upon professional development and practice with children and caregivers. In doing so, we will consider the direct effect of VIG on families, and both the direct and indirect impact of VIG on workers. We are keen to test out our findings from both the first study and our tentative findings from the current study with participants at the conference.
