Context of my research



- Innowalk (madeformovement.com)
- Innowalk Pro is a robotic device which provides movement for those unable to move on their own

Well-being

Based upon my Doctoral work the construct of well-being is poorly understood for children with complex disabilities

Research question and aims

Research question:

• How can the well-being of children and young people with complex disabilities be better understood, from using the Innowalk?

• Aims of the study:

- To pilot, by observations, develop and test an observational scale that enables well-being indicators to be recorded with children and young people with complex disabilities.
- 2. To obtain child and parental opinions by written diary records and an interview related to well-being, following them using the Innowalk.

Co-production- starting out- mapping your stakeholders (before ethical approval and grant application)

- Building your team of co-producers
 - Who are the stakeholders that will be interested in your research findings?

Non ambulant and non-verbal children and young people (CYP) and adults;


Carers and parents;

Teachers;


Technology designers

I was away for a week and my PA noticed that without the Innowalk, I had more spasms. So, it really helps my body to feel more relaxed.

Development of the research protocol-Involvement

- Explored ideas with an adult with Cerebral palsy and an 8 year old via Microsoft Teams.
- Discussed aspects of well-being and the Innowalk- used pictures of animals with the 8 year old to describe comfort, calmness, energy, and joy.
- Ethical application submitted on the back of this Patient and Public Involvement (HCARE have their own PPI group –led by Dr Katy Hamana).

Funding applications- Collaboration

- 2021-2022- 5 applications submitted- successful with a 1-year bursary from a clinical interest group, Association of Paediatric Chartered Physiotherapists.
- Data collection in a special school gatekeepers were healthcare professionals, who passed on research details to parents.
- Guest in school for 14 field observational visits- new well-being scale tested.

Analysis- Involve and collaborate

Researcher led

• Need for statistics help with well-being measure- Dr Nicola Gale

• Individual results sent to each child and family with comments invited.

Pause and reflect about how to Empower disabled children

- More funding applied for to create "My Adventures in the Innowalk" story booklet- to use the participants own words.
- Revised ethical application.
- Baily Thomas Charitable Fund research award 2023- 24- 6 months- to employ an illustrator- Alison Howard.
