

Tailored Tactics: Measuring Peer Support Impact through Personalisation

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Setting the Scene

- The aim of the Student Mentor Scheme is to support first-year students with their *transition into university life* and cultivate a *strong sense of belonging*
- Every first-year undergraduate student can *access* a student mentor from their school and are contacted *before they arrive* to university
- Student mentors help first-year students settle in by offering *impartial, informed and up-to-date advice*
- Over 40,000 first-year students have been supported by 5,000 student mentors who have provided 17,000 mentoring sessions


Early Intervention

- In 2022/23 we *checked in* with first-year students towards the end of October
- A total of 464 responses were received, out of which 33% (n=151) necessitated some form of action
- This included allocating them a new student mentor, re-introducing them to their existing mentor or signposting to an appropriate support service
- This enabled us to *intervene early* to ensure ongoing support which can impact the student experience and potentially, retention


Did you know there was a student mentor scheme when you started at Cardiff University?

Being part of the student mentor scheme helped me navigate my way around campus, finding lecture theatres, libraries and study spaces...





Supporting Retention

- Student mentors support with *academic and social integration* (Tinto, 1993)
- **24%** (*n* = 51) of students considered withdrawing from university
- 63% (n = 32) of students reported that having a student mentor influenced their decision to stay
- 762 first-year students considered withdrawing but **69%** (*n* = 523) of those stated that having a student mentor influenced their decision to stay (2016-24)



Making a difference

Personalise it...

- Personalise emails using mail merge
- Include emojis to inject some fun
- Small incentives to encourage survey completion
- Carefully consider survey design and questions
- Free-text comments are key
- Acknowledge and act on feedback
