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Ernest Aris's Catalogue

I have compiled a unique illustrated catalogue in Volume II as a means of supporting the critical assessment of Ernest Aris's work in Volume I of this thesis. The illustrated catalogue comprises of four parts:

Part one includes Aris literary publications, which consists of a detailed bibliographic record, accompanied by an image of the cover of each book that he wrote and illustrated under his own name and pseudonyms, alongside a compendium list of books Aris illustrated for other authors and other publications. In addition, I have included foreign translations and prominent books Aris illustrated for other eminent authors.

Part two is a record of Aris's commercial advertising, which includes the early series of pictorial postcards that Aris completed for leading quality publishers at the beginning of his career from 1904-1909, although it should be noted that many have later used stamp dates. There are the six pictorial natural history posters, which Aris was commissioned to undertake for the London Transport tram system in 1915, three of which now reside in the National Collection of Posters at the V&A Museum.

Part three comprises of Aris's collectibles and contains the four unique series of cigarette cards that Aris designed for leading tobacco manufacturers issued between 1929 - 1935.

Part four is a comprehensive description of each of the limited editions and subtle colour variants of the Cococub lead figurines inserted into Bournville Children's Cocoa, which Aris created designed and were manufactured by William Britain and distributed from 1934-1936. Other incidental commercial work by Aris has been included such as board games, jigsaws, calendar and a unique set of Whist scoring cards.

PART 1

Ernest Aris Publications

Aris was author and illustrator of 167 books, which have been listed overleaf by publisher in date order. A number of the books and series have been reprinted by different publishers at a later date such as the ribbon books and the Uncle Toby Tales. Aris's literary career commenced after working for other author's before he wrote and illustrated his own books.

The catalogue consists of a detailed bibliographic record, accompanied by an image of the cover of each book that he wrote and illustrated under his own name and pseudonyms Robin A. Hood and Dan Crow. There are a number of books that have been included as they are known to exist by reference or as part of a series, even though no copies can be found, probably because limited copies were produced and the nature of children's books mean fewer survive. It has been possible to insert physical descriptions and notes regarding absent books if they are part of a series produced in the same format. Titles highlighted in red have not been catalogued, although inserted into the title list, as it is impossible to certify their existence, although known to exist as they are part of a series by another publisher. In addition, there is a compendium list of books Aris illustrated for other authors, other publications and Annuals. I have also included foreign translations and prominent books Aris illustrated for other eminent authors.

Aris initially published his books through Henry Frowde, Hodder and Stoughton and moved to Gale and Polden. After the allegations of plagiarism from Frederick Warne and Beatrix Potter, Aris penned a number of books using a pseudonym Robin A. Hood. On completion of his national service Aris published the Bold Bad Mouse and Tufty Series through S.W. Partridge and produced a prolific number of books with Humphrey Milford.

In Aris's final years, he moved away from children's literature and produced a number of education books as his hearing deteriorated. His publications are unique in that even today

the tales remain visually captivating and enchanting to a broad audience. Few authors have been such a profusely diverse range of books, as well as illustrating over two hundred for other authors. This catalogue demonstrates Aris's creativity of his cover designs and is the first unique list of his books, translations and reprints.

It should be noted all the above information is assuming this book exists, it would be identical to others in the series and acts as a guide only.

It was recently discovered there was an entry in the British Library Integrated Catalogue for a title *Une Histoire de Jeannot Lapin*, which in English translates as 'A History of Jeannot Rabbit'. It has always thought that only two of the original Tasseltip Tales were translated into the French language; *Le Petit Tablier de Soie* (The Little Silk Apron) and *Taupinet Pend La Cremaillere* (Mr Mole's House Warming).

The British Library credit the author as being Anne-Marie Menanteau, but it is thought this could be an error by the British Library. Anne-Marie Menanteau was the translator, and not the author, for the two, already known, french Tasseltip titles, as well as the two French editions of *The Adventures of Wonk* (417). It is known that a few of the British Library Ladybird archive entries are wrong. For instance, the artwork for this obscure title is attributed to Ernest **E** Aris, instead of Ernest **A** Aris.!

In addition, there is a listing for 'Histoire de Jeannot Lapin' by Beatrix Potter (Publisher: F. Warne (January 1, 1949).

Ernest Aris Posters

Aris provided a series of six natural history posters of wildlife in 1915, three for the Metropolitan Electric Tramways: *The Field Mouse at Home* to Middlesex Meadows and Sudbury, *The Fox at Home* to Hertfordshire Fields and Enfield, *The Squirrel at Home* to Waltham Cross. None of the original posters have survived, only photographic images are recorded in London Transports Archive Books at the London Transport Museum.

Aris designed three further posters for the London United Tramways: *The Kingfisher at Home* to Hampton Court or Kew Bridge, *The Dragonfly at Home* to Malden Fountain and Kingston Hill, *The Pheasant at Home* to Buckinghamshire Woods at Uxbridge. The V&A Acquisition form for the only three that remain in existence states the size for each panel as: *The Kingfisher* 11 7/8 x 7 3/8, *The Dragonfly* 11 13/16 x 7 3/8, *The Pheasant* 11 7/8 x 7 3/8. Five hundred copies were ordered of each lithograph and the edition was printed by Johnson Riddle & Co. Ltd., London (printers of the first London Underground Map), at a cost of £90 each between 15 April 1915 and 8 May 1915.

These posters were designed to promote the location of the tram, perhaps each animal is representative of a particular destination. The series of images were designed to be displayed in isolation or as a series.










The theory is that there are three sets; one with red trousers, red tie and orange legs, a second set with red trousers, a matching tie and hat with yellow legs and a third set, similar to the first but with blue trousers.





Hurry-Scurry




Hurry-Scurry box cover and figures

Ernest Aris designed Hurry-Scurry, a children's board game manufactured by Chad Valley in 1915. The rules were printed inside the lid and include the story for the game. Playing the game enables the participant to discover how the story ends. "Hurry –Scurry" is a race an chase game where a dice is thrown and a counter, being a character printed on thin card and slotted into a metal base, is moved around a numbered baord.

These figures were packaged in a box illustrated by charcters from Aris's books, Willie Mouse, Billie Rabbit, who both appeared in their own books. Daisy Duck, (Frisky Series of Cigarette cards), Susie Squirrel (*Tasseltip Tales*) and Mr March Hare (Bunkum Brown Bandit).


The Cococub Race Game



The Cococub Race Game Board

The Cococub Race Game was introduced in March 1935 by Cadbury as a promotion to Cococub Club members. Members completed an application form contained in a newspaper advertisement and collected vouchers, which were exchanged for the board game. The game consisted of one hundred squares. The first player would throw the dice and proceed from Mr Pie Porker's Garden to Granny Owls Tuck Shop and return. Each player's progress would be rewarded or impeded with a penalty, similar to snakes and ladders. The winner of the game was advised to "Ask mother for a bar of Cadbury's Milk Chocolate". The rules 'the Story of the Game' is printed on the reverse o the thin board of The Cococub Race Game.

'Cocub' - The 'Cococubs' Game

Cadbury had formed a Collector's Club in 1936 in response to the popularity of the Cococub promotion. Cocub was introduced in November 1935 and priced at 1 shilling.


The boxed game consisted of four boards each named as a character, *Whiskers, Jonathan, Willie* and *Dumpty*. Each board had ten squares and players drew a card from a deck of 40 cards (with 22 different designs) with the objective of filling their board before another player, similar to Bingo. There was also an aeroplane card and the player who was dealt this card, then drew the first card from the reshuffled pack of cards.

Many of the cards were reproduced from drawings featured in the *Cococub Annual* introduced for Christmas (December, 1936).

Members were encouraged to collect coupons in exchange for a variety of toys and games. The Cocub game was also available for 7 coupons in an envelope form and the cards would be cut from a single sheet.

Sunny Stories Calendar 1946 and 1950



The verse was by Enid Blyton and pictures by Ernest Aris.

Ernest Aris had produced a number of books with Enid Blyton and her publishers George Newnes, which included *The Book of Brownies* (1926), *The Further Adventures of Brer Rabbit* (19126), *Birds of our* Gardens (1940) and the *Boys and Girls Story Book No. 3,4*, and 5 (1935) with the News Chronicle.

Aris provided the illustrations for the Sunny Stories Calendar 1950 with Enid Blyton and her publishers George Newnes. The images were taken from *Down on the Farm* which Aris illustrated and was written by R.K & M.I.R. Polkinghorne (1947).

Whist Scoring Cards



Boots Progressive Society Whist Scoring Cards were designed and illustrated by Ernest Aris. The cards were purchased with other Art Deco cards all dating from circa 1920-1930. The box lid states there were originally twelve cards with a pencil and tassel attached. The cigarette cards Aris illustrated (1925) were printed by Mardon Son & Hall of Bristol, who became involved in the production and printing of playing cards. It is quite possible through his association of cigarette cards that he became involved with providing other commercial products for Mardons, who may have been the producer of this set.
