Starting points

<u>Delegation of the European Union to Canada: Press Releases</u> are relevant to the broader European community or more specifically to EU-Canada relations.

<u>Mission of Canada to the European Union: Media Room</u> features government-issued press releases on Canada-EU relations, with links to relevant official departments and ministries.

The European Commission maintains an index of documents and publications dealing with bilateral relations, trade agreements, and dispute settlements between Canada and the EU, while the European Union's External Action Service (EEAS) also provides updates on Canada-EU relations.
